# Paulina Court Condo Board Meeting Minutes

#### Treasurer's Report

Judi presented a brief budget summary and reported that the 2011 end-of-year budget summary will be available at the next board meeting. All special assessment payments that were due in November are up to date; however, there is currently a delinquency of approximately \$400 for regular assessments. This does not include the assessment amount owed for the 5920-2E unit, which currently stands at \$8,200. This total continues to decrease from the income received from the unit rental.

#### Old Business

### • Building masonry repair project

Mark reported that the masonry restoration project contract with Dakota-Evans Restoration was vetted by the association lawyer and has been signed. Alan Gold will be in contact with Dakota-Evans and KGH to determine a tentative project start date and work schedule for later this spring.

### • 5920-2E Unit Status Update

Mark reported that the lease for 5920-2E has been extended for an additional 6 months to the current tenant. As with the 2011 lease, the terms of the new lease will continue to be contingent upon any changes to the foreclosure status of the unit.

For the remainder of the meeting the board went into closed session to discuss updates to the foreclosure status of 5920-2E and what impact that may have upon the future rental of the unit and for protecting the investment the association had made to make the unit rental ready.

The meeting adjourned at 7:25 P.M.
